## INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Anchor BCI Diversified Moderate Fund is a multi-managed portfolio with a moderate risk profile that aims to provide investors with a moderate long-term total return. This Fund is appropriate for clients who want exposure to Anchor's capabilities in a solution that is appropriately blended and diversified with other offerings to ensure a more consistent return profile.

## INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

The portfolio will be managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa to the extent allowed for by the Act. The portfolio's equity exposure is limited to a maximum of 60% of the portfolio's net asset value. In order to achieve its objective, the investments normally to be included in the portfolio may comprise a combination of assets in liquid form, money-market instruments, interest-bearing securities, bonds, debentures, corporate debt, equity securities, other interest-bearing securities, property securities, preference shares, convertible equities and non-equity securities. The portfolio may, from time to time, invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes.

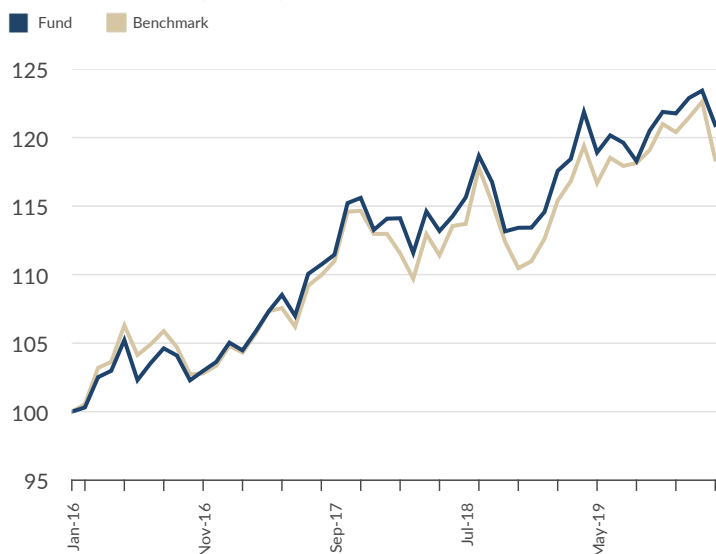

- The probability of losses is higher than that of a low-risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio and moderate long term investment returns are expected.

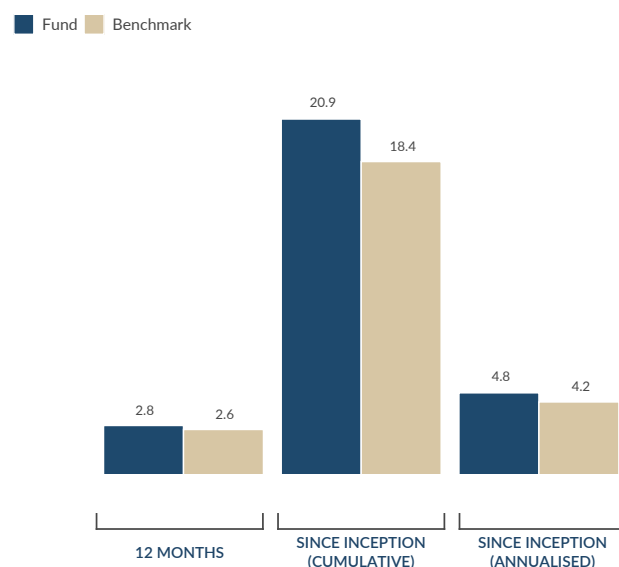
## FUND PERFORMANCE SINCE INCEPTION

Growth of R100 investment (cumulative).



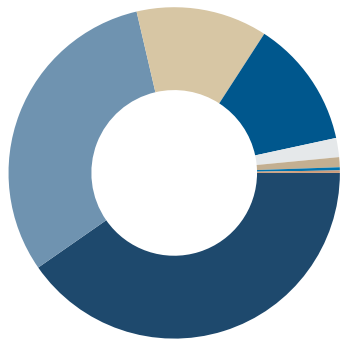

## FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY AT 29 FEB 2020

The Anchor BCI Diversified Moderate fund declined 2.0% for the month, outperforming the category average which declined 3.4%.

February was one of the worst months for equities since the global financial crisis. Markets retreated sharply and the equity market, as measured by the FTSE/JSE Capped Swix All Share Index, was no exception losing 9.6%. Consequently, the Satrix Capped Swix All Share Index tracker fund depreciated 9.6%. The ClucasGray Equity Fund, Perpetua SCI Equity fund and the Anchor BCI Equity fund lost 9.1%, 10.8% and 7.6% respectively. The SIM Small Cap fund declined 8.4%.

With the volatility Index on the US stock market more than doubling, the GinsGlobal European Equity fund, GinsGlobal Equity fund and the iShares Core MSCI Emerging ETF fell 8.8%, 8.5% and 5.5% respectively, in Dollar terms. Concerns around the impact of the coronavirus on the world's economy drove the Rand 4.2% lower against the US Dollar. Consequently, GinsGlobal European Equity fund and GinsGlobal Equity fund fell 4.3% and 4.0% respectively, whilst the iShares Core MSCI Emerging ETF declined 0.9% in Rand terms.

Local bonds retreated slightly, with the IFM Bond fund declining 0.1%, in line with the ALBI which also declined 0.1% for the month.

The IFM Income and Anchor Income segregated mandate appreciated 0.4% and 0.4% respectively, while Cash generated 0.5% during the month.
